### Prior to Your Departure:

Contact Joanne at Uniglobe Carefree Travel to book your airfare into Saskatoon. Just tell Joanne that you are planning a trip to Hatchet, and she will do the rest! **We highly recommend that you purchase trip cancellation/interruption insurance, see below for new information regarding travel protection insurance.**

### Hotel Stay in Saskatoon – night before your departure to the Lodge

Clay will make your hotel reservation in Saskatoon for you. Making it one less step for you in planning your Trip of a Lifetime! To do so, Clay will need to know how many rooms and what type of room you would like to reserve. Our partner hotel offers rooms with (1) queen bed, (2) queen beds and (1) king bed. If you have any preferences regarding your hotel stay, please pass that information along to Clay. Reservations will be made at the beginning of 2026; once the reservation is made you will be emailed a confirmation number.

- \* **Weight Limit: 50 pounds per person max. Anything over will not make it onto the aircraft NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- \* **To clear Customs, you'll need a passport.**

**Do not rely on your US driver's license/birth certificate as proof of US citizenship.**

### Upon Arrival at the John Diefenbaker Airport in Saskatoon

Hail any taxi at the airport and have them take you and your gear to the Delta Hotels by Marriott Saskatoon Downtown (10 Minute Ride; approx. \$20-\$25 Canadian).

## The Morning of Your Departure from the Delta Saskatoon

A Hatchet Lake Lodge "Ground Coordinator" will be onsite in the lobby to ensure that you and your gear find your way to the private bus transportation departing at 5:45 AM sharp for the Saskatoon Airport. Our chartered flight to the lodge is airborne at 6:30 AM. You will arrive at the lodge at 9:00 AM for breakfast, following breakfast you will head out on the lake to fish.

**Note:** The last day of your trip is a travel day... You will leave the lodge at 9:00 AM and arrive in Saskatoon around 11:30. **We recommend you schedule your connecting flight any time after 2:00 PM.**

## \$6,250 for a 5 day/4-night stay – 4 days of guided fishing

\* An additional \$500 per day will be added for singles and odd numbered groups. For odd numbered groups this additional fee can be applied pro rata to all members of the group.

### RATES INCLUDE:

- Roundtrip airfare from Saskatoon, Saskatchewan to Hatchet Lake Lodge
- Daily breakfast, shore lunch and a home cooked dinner
- Bottled water and pop
- 1-, 2- & 4-person log cabins with individual bedrooms, running water, hot showers and high efficiency wood burning stoves
- 18' Alumarine boat with swivel seats, 40HP Yamaha outboard motors and gas
- Professional guide for every 2 anglers

### ADDITIONAL ITEMS:

- Liquor (available at the Lodge)
- Rod and reel rentals (\$25/day, must be booked 30 days in advance)
- Fishing tackle – the main lodge holds a fully stocked tackle shop
- Daily fly-outs to surrounding lakes – flyout price for 2025 - \$600/per person
- **All taxes – 6% PST and 5% GST on all packages and incidentals. The roundtrip airfare from Saskatoon to the lodge is charged tax free**
- Annual Saskatchewan Fishing License [www.environment.gov.sk.ca/licences](http://www.environment.gov.sk.ca/licences) or call toll free: 1 (855) 848-4773, available for purchase after April 1st

### PAYMENT METHOD:

- Personal cheque, Visa or MasterCard – Deposit of \$2,000 per person is due by September 15, 2025, or at the time of booking to confirm date
- An additional \$2,000 payment per person is due December 1, 2025, to continue holding your date
- Full payments are due by April 1, 2026. Our cancellation policy is 90 days prior to departure, and all payments are **NON-REFUNDABLE**
- **2.4% Transaction Fee will be charged on all credit card payments**

\*All prices are in USD and subject to change without prior notice due to fuel prices and/or unforeseen economic circumstances

### TRAVEL NOTES:

- Total luggage weight is 50 LBS per person.
- Direct charter flights depart June, July & August: Northbound departs Saskatoon @ 6:30 AM, Southbound arrives in Saskatoon at 12 noon, please make your flight arrangements leaving Saskatoon for any time after 2 PM

### CANCELLATION POLICY

- **HLL will not pay cash refund** – if cancelling prior to the 90-day period, your refund less all amounts paid prior April 1<sup>st</sup> will be in the form of a credit for the following year
- If cancelling within the 90-day period, all payments are forfeited
- Cancelled trips inside the 90-day cancellation timeframe will not be 'rolled over' to future seasons
